CID Macedonia is very happy to announce you that the project we applied to the Macedonian National Agency for the Youth in Action Programme has been approved. The Training course will take place in Macedonia from **16-23 August 2013**.

We hereby kindly ask you to recruit participants from your organizations that will be able to participate at the training course.

About the project

The project aims to develop competences of trainers active and experienced in youth work in designing and delivering educational programmes to facilitate inclusion, initiate employability and work with marginalized youth. The project will put specific focus on working with institutionalized youth such as young people in orphanages, day care centers, juvenile delinquency institutions, etc. It will be 7 day training course, organized in Macedonia and will gather youth workers and youth leaders from 14 youth organizations from Europe. Improving quality of the educational programs and making them more accessible, according to needs of young people at risk, is one of the main aims to achieve. The outcomes of the project are long term, as the team of trained trainers will continue to develop programs that will increase participation of young people in the community and empower and build confidence.

The training course has the following objectives:

- To increase participants' understanding of the social inclusion and how to ensure quality educational programs
- To provide participants with the theory and tools necessary to design, implement and evaluate effective inclusive training programs with targets of youth at risk
- To provide participants with tools and knowledge how to provide trainings on skill and competence building and how to assess and follow learning for youth at risk
- To provide tools for empowerment and competence building of young people at risk and how to facilitate the initiatives for employment
- To improve their competences in using European programs for youth work and tools at the local level
- To develop their organizations' capacity on the organizing trainings with non-formal education with focus on target such as youth at risk

- Youth workers and young trainers active within the organizations
- Be motivated to develop their competences as trainers for youth at risk and youth in institutions
- Be committed to attend for the full duration of the course
- Be minimum 18 years old
- Able to work in English language
