

Call for EVS volunteer in Slovenia

Name of the project: **Youth opportunity project**

Duration of the project: **6 months**, from 1.9.2015 till 28.2.2016

The project is financed by Key Action 1 of Erasmus+ Programme

Organization and place: **Mladinski center Krško** (Youth center Krško)

Tasks of the volunteer:

- work on the centers existing programs (multimedia, children, sports, prevention, international, culture, informal education, information center,...) (5,5 hours/week)
- work in information center and spending time with young visitors of the center (4,5 h/week)
- organize an opened national evening where he/she will present his/her own culture in Youth center Krško
- present his/her own country, language and culture and EVS to children in kindergarden, primary school and highschool
- work on his/her own project with the support of youth centers staff (7,5 h/week)
- work on his/her own program in youth center for our young people (9,5 h/week)
- attend weekly meetings (1,5 hours/week) with a mentor
- attend weekly staff meetings and coordinator meetings (2 h/week)
- attend Slovenian language course (3 h/week)
- share his/her experience about EVS and their country with young visitors in our youth center
- share his/her experience about EVS and their country with pupils and students on information hours in local primary and high school
- support the visibility of the project, Erasmus+ program and the support of the EU in sending organizations local community, his/her own country.

Self initiative of the volunteer is encouraged and the development of own ideas is supported so the volunteer can focus on the field they are interested in and work on that.

Practical arrangements:

Food: The amount for food per month is 160 Euro. Volunteers will cook their own food. They are responsible for buying and making their own food.

Accommodation: The volunteer will have an own room in an apartment, where there will be 2 volunteers sharing a bathroom and kitchen. The room is located in the Hostel of our Youth hostel.

Language support: We provide slovenian laguage courses (3h/week), wich will be given by a mentor who has a lot of experiance in the filed of teaching slovenian language. For those who have weaker knowledge of English, there will also be an online language course, you can read more about it on this website: <http://erasmusplusols.eu/>

Equipment (phone, internet, etc.): When you come to Krško we provide you with a Slovenian phone number and a phone (you have to pay for the charging by yourself). There will be internet access in the apartment and youth center. There is a bycicle you can use at all times. Drying and washing machine is also available for your use.

Pocket money: 85 Euro per month

Insurance: The volunteer will be insured by the AXA insurance plan by the sending organization.

Youth center Krško is a public organization. It was established in 2001 by Municipality Krško for organizing youth programs. Our programs are informing and advising, prevention, education, culture, multimedia, creative past time, international programs, programs for children. We also connect and support other local youth organizations and unorganized youngsters.

Our programs are made for all groups of people, whatever rase, etical, religion, sexual orientation, belief. We promote our programs and encourage young people to be active and to help making the program.
