



II THEME OF THE EVS

The Portuguese Red Cross Youth hosts four young volunteers from 1st March 2016 to 28th February 2017 in the city of Braga and in the village of Prado (Portugal) in a project called: "B.A.M! Be Active - Move!".

During 12 months, these volunteers will carry out different activities that aim to foster solidarity in children and youngsters, not only amongst themselves, but also towards every human being, regardless of nationality, gender or race. Volunteers will carry out activities in order to work effectively in the social inclusion of children and vulnerable young people living in Bairro Social de Santa Tecla (a problematic district) and Vila de Prado which is a small village near Braga in which they will be working with children and youngsters from the Roma Community. They will also collaborate in a social shop, Ponto Vermelho that aims at helping needed families and fighting poverty. The volunteers can also help in the International Cooperation area and other fields as Design, Marketing and Communication.

All the activities will deal with topics that are of prime concern in the youth field: health promotion and education, such as eating habits, alcohol and drug abuse, or promoting physical activity. They will also promote school inclusion especially through digital skills. Volunteers will promote actions in schools; develop leisure activity; develop and help organizing sports and learning activities during holidays but also during school time.
